DSC Expanding Lead-Acid Battery Factory in Iowa

East Penn Manufacturing, the maker of DEKA batteries, is expanding their existing 100,000 SF factory in Corydon, IA, to include a new production line of lead acid batteries that will be started there and finished in another plant. East Penn Manufacturing produces batteries and battery accessories for cars, marine, industrial, agriculture, commercial, and other markets.

DSC crews are currently working on the new 208,000 SF addition, tripling the size of the facility and quadrupling their potential battery output.

Crews installed approximately 14,000 cubic yards of concrete in the foundations and slabs, 8,000 cubic yards of concrete for the parking areas, and 386 tons of reinforcing steel. Also included in our scope of work is installation of the insulated

metal panel outer skin and roof

membrane. The project is estimated to be completed early next year.



Once complete, the company hopes to hire over 200 people. East Penn Manufacturing, headquartered in Lyons Station, PA, had purchased the assets of Voltmaster Co., another battery manufacturer, in Corydon in 2006. East Penn was recently recognized by Forbes as being one of America's Best Large Employers for 2018.

New Fitness Center Coming to Mason City

DSC crews are currently doing an interior buildout on the west end of the former Kmart building in Mason City for Planet Fitness. The 12,000 SF space will be renovated to include framing, drywall, acoustical ceilings, signage, vinyl wall coverings, decorating, and interior painting for one of the largest fitness club franchises.

What was previously the service bay area for Kmart, crews first provided structural steel work and demolition for Furniture Mart, the owner of the building, in order to prep it for lease to Planet Fitness. Crews demoed block walls, poured concrete to level the floors, took out overhead doors, and opened up the lavout.



This fast-paced project for Planet Fitness will be their first location in North Iowa. Known for their bright and clean facilities, the fitness center will include a large selection of purple & yellow Planet Fitness branded cardio, circuit, and weight-training equipment.

A basic membership is \$10/month, while those upgrading to Black Card status for \$23/month will enjoy access to additional benefits such as a spa area, tanning beds, hydromassage beds, massage chairs, and access to their 1,800+ locations. Planet Fitness promotes a high-quality fitness experience in a welcoming, non-intimidating environment.

Crews started the buildout in September and will be completed with their portion in December. Planet Fitness hopes to open before the end of the year.

DSC Builds Two New Kwik Stars in Des Moines Metro

This summer Dean Snyder Construction broke ground on two new gas station/convenience stores in the Des Moines, IA, area for Kwik Star, also known as Kwik Trip in Minnesota and Wisconsin.

Projects included a 7,500 SF store in Grimes with a 2,000 SF detached one-bay automatic car wash, as well as a 9,300 SF store in Ankeny with an attached car wash. Grimes opened Friday, November 29 while Ankeny opened in

late October. DSC self-performed steel erection, finish carpentry, and EPI panels and has been working with the Kwik Star/Kwik Trip company since completing a new gas station in Clear Lake in 2015.

The company typically looks for locations that can be reached easily from its headquarters in Wisconsin as 80 percent of the food items sold in the store including bread, muffins, pizza, doughnuts, and milk are made in LaCrosse and supplied to stores daily. Locations also sell bananas, eggs, and onions for in-between trips to the grocery store as well as hot, ready-toeat meal options such as cheeseburgers, pizza, burritos, and chicken sandwiches.

The company operates Kwik Trip, Kwik Star, Tobacco Outlet Plus, and Tobacco Outlet Plus Grocery stores, has over 600 locations across lowa, Wisconsin, and Minnesota, and more than 2,300 employees. The family-owned company serves 9 million customers a week and are known for their friendly service and quality products at a fair, low price.

TimberCrest 48-Unit Apartment Complex Near Completion in Clear Lake

One Vision's TimberCrest will soon offer maintenance-free living in their senior-focused apartments, ranging in size from 778 SF to 1,325 SF.
